PRIVILEGE FROM THE FLOOR: David Brong of Sunset Beach Drive addressed the Town Board about a culvert that runs under Lake Road that was clogged. Highway Superintendent Jim Bailey said that a stump was washed into it and that it is now repaired.

HIGH SPEED INTERNET: Chuck Bartosh of Clarity Connect appeared before the Town Board to discuss details on the high speed internet service that will be installed in Southern Cayuga County. The Town of Ledyard will receive high speed internet service via two 60-70 ft. high telephone poles in Ledyard and one in Interlaken, NY, with a new technology. According to Mr. Bartosh, Ledyard should be at the top of the list for installation and should be up and running within three months. Residents should sign up with Clarity Connect, through their website, for service. Cost per household will be \$49.95 per month, and if paid quarterly will be \$44.95, and if paid annually will cost \$35.95. Installation will cost \$199.00. Prices for businesses will be different. There will be one free hot spot in the Town of Ledyard, perhaps at the Town Hall or the library.
